OVERVIEW

This course is designed for those who are passionate about supporting people in their community. CHC22015 Certificate II in Community Services provides foundational knowledge and skills to support individuals on their pathway to entry level roles in Community Services, including Youth Work, Disability and Aged Care.

Community Service workers provide support, programs, activities, and information for those who need it most, linking people with the appropriate services, groups and communities.

Upon successful completion of the qualification students may be eligible for up to 4 QCE credits as nominated by the QCAA.

COURSE DELIVERY AND FEES

The HyFlex Skills learning platform delivers Community Services learning and teaching resources online via Learning Bytes and Supplementary Assessments. Learning Bytes are engaging, self-assessing online training modules. Schools receive weekly reports on student's progress. Teachers have a supervisory role and complete third party observation reports on student performance in Supplementary Assessments. Schools may also choose for students to undertake Supplementary Assessment in a workplace.

This course is funded through VETiS and is free of charge for eligible students. Students not eligible for VETiS funding can contact their School's VET Coordinator for more information, including fee-for-service options.
